Excellent edibles became abundantly available this summer in the Tri-state region with the opening of three new shops that have limited seating and many to-go options.

The baking-cooking-catering team of Pete Hathaway and Bruce Young opened Hathaway Young in Millerton this summer, at 56 South Center St., selling tender baked goods, quality coffee and a range of other prepared goods, including a large assortment of soups.

The hours are Monday through Saturday 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Sunday from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. The website is [www.hathawayyoung.com/shop](http://www.hathawayyoung.com/shop).

The White Hart inn on the historic Green in Salisbury now has a take-out shop with a communal table, some smaller tables for two people and a range of breakfast and lunch options.

Beverages are a priority, with Number Six Depot Roastery coffees from West Stockbridge, and assorted freshly made sodas that change depending on what fruits and herbs are available to crush into them.

The shop was designed by Megan Wilson of Cornwall and features an assortment of quirky goods from her online store, [www.ancientindustries.com](http://www.ancientindustries.com).

The menu was designed by the inn's head chef, Annie Wayte, and is a mix of salads, sandwiches and some hot dishes. There are cookies, there are cakes, there's toast with mashed avocado and red pepper flakes.

For now the new shop, called Provisions, is open Friday, Saturday and Monday from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Sunday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. The website is [www.whitehartinn.com/provisions](http://www.whitehartinn.com/provisions).

In August, the J.P. Gifford's take-out shop in Kent expanded to a new, smaller location in Sharon on West Main Street (in the space formerly home to Roaring Oaks flower shop, extensively renovated by new building owner Rafe Churchill).

The Sharon shop has indoor and outdoor seating and the same menu of baked goods, breakfast options and lunch goods (sandwiches, salads, noodles, cold salmon) that are offered in Kent. The menus at both are created by chef Mike Moriarty.

The shop is open Tuesday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Saturday and Sunday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Plan extra time for visiting with friends; the eatery (with indoor and outdoor seating) has quickly turned into a social hub.

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
